In a classroom with no electricity or blackboard, he finds himself with only a yak and a song that echoes through the mountains. Shoplifters

Shoplifters is a multilayered discussion of poverty and survival. On the margins of Tokyo, a dysfunctional band of outsiders is united by fierce loyalty and a penchant for petty theft. The film is contemplative and loud as it explores these complex characters and their relationships.
