The Sapphires

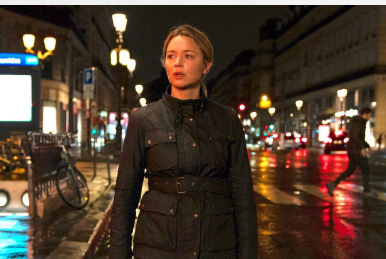

Revoir Paris

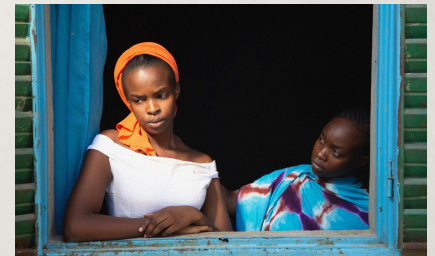
